

Permitted Movement: Definitions & Processes



Permitted Movement



Permitting is the mechanism to grant permission of movements during an HPAI outbreak.

Definitions -

Permit:

Approves the movement of a specific item from a specific origin to a specific destination. The origin and destination State must approve a permit for interstate movement.

Movement:

Each movement of that product between the specified origin and destination associated with that permit. There may be multiple movements against one permit.

- Is premises in Control Area?

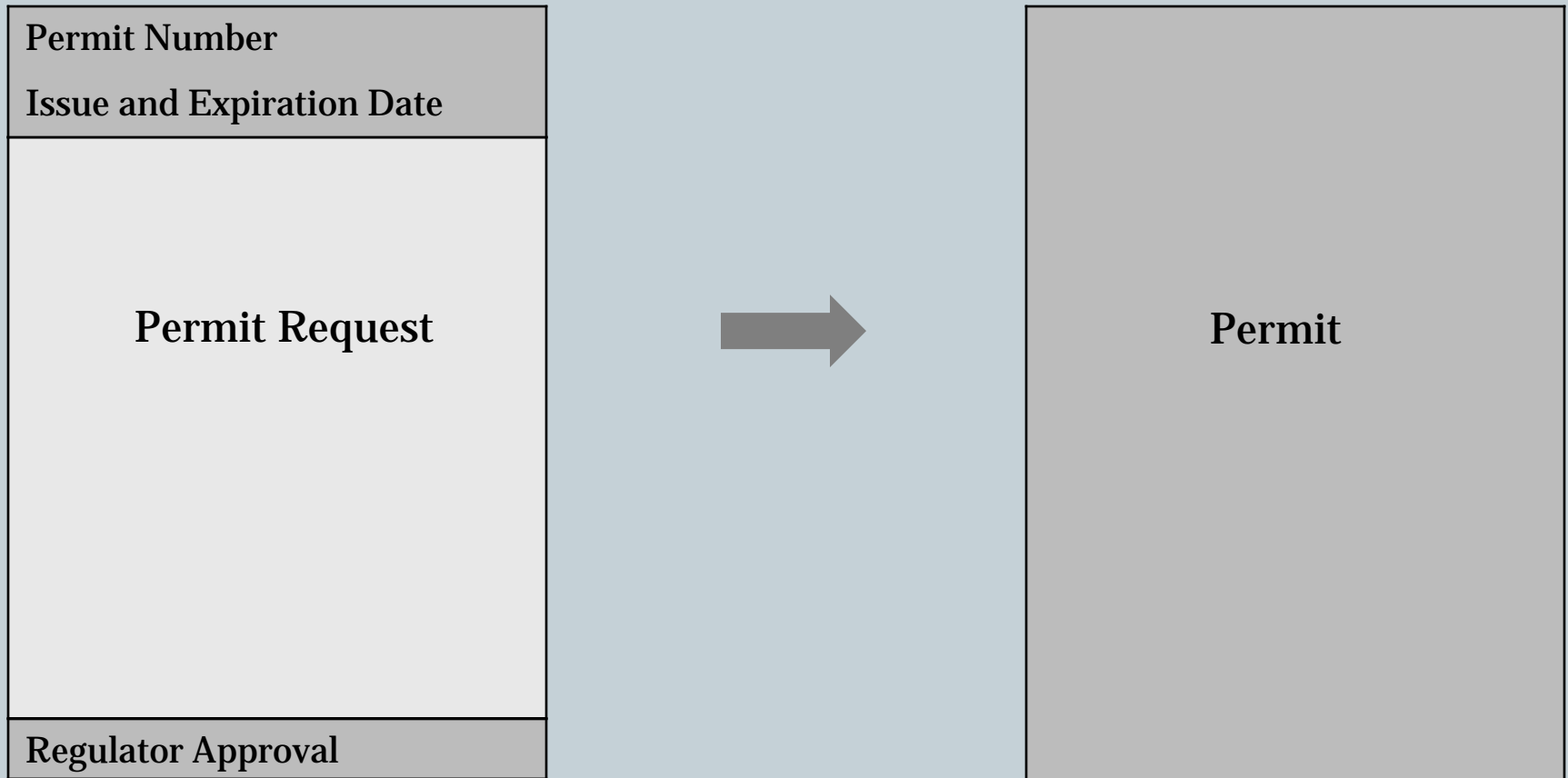
